HISTORY FACTS

Thanksgiving's history in America dates back to the 1621 harvest feast shared by Plymouth colonists and the Wampanoag tribe, though this was not an annual event. The tradition of holding days of thanksgiving continued, but it wasn't until 1863 that President Abraham Lincoln declared the last Thursday of November as a national Thanksgiving holiday, largely due to the persistent efforts of writer Sarah Josepha Hale. Congress officially established the fourth Thursday in November as a national holiday in 1941.
